

### S.1 - S.5 First Term Examination

#### Dear Parents,

The details of the S.1-S.5 First Term Examination and related issues are listed below. It is hoped that parents can prod their children to get prepared for the examination.

- 1. The S.1-S.5 First Term Examination will be held from 5/1/2026 to 15/1/2026. Please read all the relevant information in this circular about the examination timetables and the revision guidelines in the annexes.
- 2. During the examination period, students should come to school and go to the examination venue by 8:10 a.m. Students must arrive at the examination venue at least 15 minutes before each examination session.
- 3. Casual leave for students during the examination period will not be allowed except for special cases. During the examination period, no matter how short the sick leave is, students have to fill in the Application for Leave column in the Student Handbook and submit a medical certificate. If a student is absent from an examination without following these procedures, he/she will receive zero marks in that subject. Absentees will not be given a make-up examination. Nonetheless, absent students should still apply for leave as stated (please refer to the Student Handbook) and submit the leave application documents to the class teacher on the next school day. The examination scores of the absentees who follow the correct procedures will be estimated based on their daily marks.
- 4. The review period of S.1-S.5 First Term Exam Scripts will be held from 16/1/2026 to 20/1/2026. Students should come to school and have lessons as usual according to the original timetable.
- 5. If the EDB announces a class suspension during the examination period, the examination(s) on that day will be rescheduled and it will be announced later. The remaining examinations will be held under the original schedule.
- 6. S.1-S.3 promotion criteria:
  - 6.1. The total average score of a student in a year should be 45 or above; and
  - 6.2. The attendance rate of a student in a year should not be less than 90%.
- 7. S.4-S.5 promotion criteria:
  - 7.1. The total average score of a student in a year should be 30 or above; and
  - 7.2. The attendance rate of a student in a year should not be less than 90%.
