

School Events in December to February

Dear Parents,

Please be reminded of the school events and holiday arrangements in December and February. Details are as followed.

1. Christmas Whole-School and Class Activities

Our school has been actively participating in the Education Bureau's "4Rs Mental Health Charter" program and consistently implementing various measures within the Charter to promote student mental health. The four key elements of the "4Rs Mental Health Charter" are (1) Rest, (2) Relaxation, (3) Relationships, and (4) Resilience. Our school will hold Christmas whole school and class activities on Friday, December 19th. Students are required to return to school as usual before 8:15 a.m. to participate in the activities, and they may leave school as early as 2:00 p.m. Our school hopes that through this event, students can relax amidst their busy studies and pay more attention to their mental health.

2. Cultural Dress Day Fundraising Activity

On the same day (December 19), the Student Union will organize the Cultural Dress Day Fundraising Activity. Students participating in Cultural Dress Day are required to place their donations into the donation box located at the school's main entrance upon arrival.
